### IMPORTANT ITEMS YOU WILL NEED TO BRING:

## **Passports**

Travellers who are not Canadian citizens are required to possess a valid passport while in Canada. Citizens of other countries should check for additional requirements prior to coming leaving home. Exercise the same safety precautions throughout your travels. We recommend carrying your passport with you at all times. It is also a advisable to carry a photocopy of the information pages in a separate area from your passport (the pages containing your photograph and passport details), and leave a copy at home.

#### Travel Insurance

We recommend that passengers purchase adequate trip cancellation/interruption, medical and luggage insurance. Details of cancellation policies can be found with our Royal Canadian Pacific Booking Form.

### Medication

By Law, Royal Canadian Pacific is unable to dispense any form of medication (including allergy or pain medications). Please carry an adequate supply of any medication you may require while traveling. Prescription medicines should always be carried in your hand luggage (not in checked luggage) in their original, labelled containers.

It is important that you check with your local physician for any vaccinations or medications regarding your personal medical condition which would be required for entry into Canada. While there are excellent medical facilities in Canada, passengers who require attention should be aware that medical care is not available on board the Royal Canadian Pacific. Travelers with physical disabilities or restrictions and those who may require medical attention should advise the Royal Canadian Pacific office of their condition at the time of booking.
